The mission of Solarize St. Thomas is to bring more clean, renewable solar energy and battery storage systems to homeowners, businesses, and non-profit organizations on the island of St. Thomas in the United States Virgin Islands.

Objectives

- **Make solar energy more accessible:** predetermined, highly vetted materials, pricing, and contractor(s) through competitive bid process;
- **Make solar energy more affordable:** lower the cost of solar energy through the power of group-purchasing and reduced acquisition costs. Pass savings to residents of St. Thomas;
- **Education and community engagement:** widespread community engagement, education and outreach activities through town hall meetings, workshops, solar “open house” gatherings, and outreach through local community groups and events;
- **Promote solar friendly policies:** encourage local governments to adopt streamlined solar energy permitting policies and fair utility distributed generation policies; and
- **Give back to community:** Solarize St. Thomas and selected contractors will use a portion of campaign proceeds to donate a solar energy system to a deserving local nonprofit organization.

Who We Are

Solarize St. Thomas is a grassroots public-private coalition currently consisting of Virgin Islands Energy Office, Rotary Club of St. Thomas East, Environmental Association of St. Thomas – St. John, Virgin Islands Conservation Society, and Solar Crowdsourcing.
